QUINTON BEMILLER HIGHLIGHTS

uinton Bemiller is a visual artist from Los Angeles. Primarily a painter, his work utilizes abstract imagery to explore concepts of history and time. "I work with acrylic on canvas, stretched over wood panels. I use a variety of brush strokes, glazes, opaque flat color and transparent applications. Working abstractly, I layer these multiple elements and use them as my vocabulary to build larger ideas.

"I started painting seriously at the age of 10 and am now 30. That's a 20 year journey to get where I am today, which is really still the beginning for me. My paintings constatntly evolve and keep me excited about will come next. I have been fortunate to have excellent painting teachers along the way: Joan Haeberlein in high school, Suzanne Bravender at Pasadena City College, Michael David and Ken Beck in Boston and most recently, at Claremont Graduate University, I have worked with Gary Lang, John Millei, Steve Roden, David Amico and Kelly McLane. I also learned from Milford Zornes, who I met in 1995 and other watercolorists like Henry Fukuhara, Chris Van Winkle, Robert Hallett and Verna Wells.

"I very much believe that painting is an inheritance, a family tradition. I am continuing the great work of artists from the past and hopefully making new work worthy for the future!"

In June 2007, the Los Angeles Art Association (LAAA) will present the first Los Angeles solo show of work by Bemiller, at their historic venue, Gallery 825. MOCA Director/Curator Jeremy Strick recently included Bemiller's work in "Biannual", a
