BILL ANDERSON HIGHLIGHTS

Bill Anderson was an art teacher for thirty-eight years in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Long Beach, Anaheim and Los Alamitos, California. He has had solo and group exhibits in California, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Italy, Holland and Mexico. His works are included in the permanent collections of the Vincent Price Museum, Bowers Museum, Carnegie Museum, National Museum of Watercolor, Mexico; and National Museum of Printmaking, Mexico. He was selected as Huntington Beach "Artist of the Year" in 1986 and is included in Who's Who in American Art and Who's Who in American Education. He is included in the "History of California Watercolor 1850-1970", by Gordon McClelland and Jay Last, 2002, as well as a book on the art of "Anderson", 1984.

Bill has been a working artist his entire life, and is a painter, printmaker, sculptor, potter, and photographer.

In 1995 the Anderson Art Gallery opened its doors on Pacific Coast Highway in Sunset Beach, California. Over these years the gallery has combined the work of California Art with Mexican Art.
