Judy Webber has spent her entire life involved in the arts, particularly visual art. She has a Bachelors/Masters in Art and a Masters of Education, Curriculum and Instruction. Additionally, she is university certified in Web Design and in Graphic Design. Judy has been a city art director, K-12 art supervisor, university art project director, chair of numerous county and regional Visual and Performing Arts Committees, CSU university lecturer in art for a number of years, UC consultant in the arts, recognized for TCAP Leadership in the arts, a two year participant in Prelude to Performance (for the arts) state project, and a secondary art teacher for over 30 years.

She is currently a watermedia artist as well as an independent contractor in web design, graphics, and education. Watercolor is Judy's media of choice although she also enjoys acrylics, mixed media, and collage. Having painted mainly realistically during her teaching career, Judy now paints using original images she perceives before she paints. She frequently paints wet on wet with watercolor glazes and spray, using chemical knowledge of what colors will do. Keen on nature subjects, Judy feels in tune with shapes and colors that create moods.

Judy Webber has exhibited in a number of venues in California, Arizona, and in Oklahoma. Additionally, she has set up gallery shows for the arts at Idyllwild, San Bernardino education center, CSUSB art education, and in Oklahoma. Webber is the web designer-webmaster for Associated Artists of the Inland Empire and for Riverside Art Museum, as well as others. She also teaches workshops at the Art Box Studio. Judy Webber is looking forward to demonstrating wet-on-wet techniques and painting on Fredrix watercolor canvas for her AAie demonstration.

So a correspondence course was purchased by Ruth's father, and she set out to learn. This independent study paid off with a rich lifelong involvement in the arts.

Ruth was introduced to pastel drawing in elementary school, and this eventually led to painting. The spark held fire all the way through college when she attended Newman University in Kansas. There she majored in Education and minored in Art. Ruth studied watercolor at Notre Dame University where she worked on her Master's Degree in Art.

After a career as an art teacher for Middle School, Ruth has retired and is pursuing art by developing her own projects. She credits Chris Van Winkle with helping her get started. Currently Ruth enjoys painting Plein Air watercolor on site. The challenge of capturing constantly changing light while maintaining a study of values keeps her paintings fresh. She also attends live model classes at the Filippi Winery, sponsored by Chaffey Art Association.

Her history of working in pastels doing everything from portraits to butterfly studies has now led to a fascination for landscapes. She was recently inspired by a trip to Scotland last summer.

Ruth has exhibited her work at the Joselyn Museum of Art in Omaha, Kent State University, as well as at local art shows for Associated Artists, Mid Valley and Chaffey Art Associations.
