ROGER FOLK HIGHLIGHTS

Recognition and growing demand for his drawings and paintings lead Roger Folk to abandon a successful commercial career as marketing art director for Disneyland, and devote himself full time to fine art. Today he is an accomplished watercolorist whose mastery in portraying a wide variety of subjects with authority and sensitivity has earned him the respect of art critics and collectors throughout the United States and the world.

Folk, who is best known for his coastscapes, paintings of shorebirds and children on the beach, also makes Yosemite National Park his studio. Since 1982 Roger has been an annual guest instructor and seminar leader. In 1986 he was invited to be the first participant in their artist-in-residence program.

Juried in as a signature member of the national Watercolor Society in 1978, he has served eight years on the Board of Directors.

Roger Folk exhibits in various judged and invitational shows annually including the Laguna Beach Festival of Arts. Two times he has been a juror for the latter, as well as many other respected shows.
