He obtained his masters degree in Art from Claremont Graduate School in 1972. Richard has had many one man art shows in Southern California. He has also participated in many group art shows. Recently he was shown in the Manzanar exhibition of watercolors from Henry Fukuhara workshop.

He was in Watercolor West 2003 juried art show. He is also a member of the National Watercolor Society.
